Community Exhibit Rules:

- All entry forms and entry fees due <u>June 20 at 4:00pm</u>.
- Entry Fees are \$1.00/entry and a membership fee of \$5.00/adult exhibitor or \$2.00/18 & under exhibitor.
- Entry forms are to be completed online @ www.macgregorfair.com
- Age as of January 1st of current calendar year.
- 18 & under may enter any Adult Section but will be judged with the adults.
- Articles can be dropped off at Stride Centre between **11:00 12:00** am or **6:00-7:00pm** Friday June 21, 2024. <u>Exhibitors are asked to respect drop off times.</u>
- Item tags may be requested early by e-mailing macgregorfair@gmail.com
- Articles must remain at the show until **4:00pm** Saturday June 22, 2024 <u>and be</u> <u>removed by the exhibitor no later than **4:30pm** Saturday June 22, 2024</u>.
- All entries must be the work of, or produced by, the Exhibitor.
- Judging will take place after 12:00pm June 22, 2024. Articles will not be accepted once judging begins. Judges decision will be final.
- In case of no competition, the judge will only give a first prize if work is worthy.
- All items are to be clean and in "like new" condition. Dusty or dirty items will be rejected for display.
- Fine art and photography are to be affixed to a poster board or mat backing in order that it may be displayed without damage.
- Prizes are: 1st \$10, 2nd \$6, 3rd \$4 **unless otherwise stated.**
- Directors are not responsible for any articles left.
- The right to alter, add or cancel any class/section is reserved by the Directors of the North Norfolk and District Ag Society whose decision will be final.
